BLENNERHASSETT BURIAL GROUND: in Kilgobban (a.k.a. Kilgobbin) C.o.I. graveyard is a large Blennerhassett vault for the Glendine Blennerhassett family, at least four generations of that family being interred here

MARTIN BURIAL GROUND: The Rector of Kilgobban also conducts services at Killiney Church (C.o.I.), whose church yard is burial place for the Martin family of Foilatrishig (Foil), near Camp; There is a strong family connection between the Martin family of Foilatrishig (Foil) and the Blennerhassett family of Devenish, Victoria, Australia (see p.D 01 & p.D 11); also Olive Thickett (L 05) tells that "...there was always a strong bond between the Martin and Blennerhassett families in Camp..." i.e. Between Martins of Foilatrishig (Foil) and Blennerhassetts of Glendine; it is reasonable to suppose that Blennerhassett families of Glendine, Co.Kerry and of Devenish, Australia are themselves directly related, but no proof of this yet found

VERMONT, USA:

OLD WOODEN TRUNK

an old wooden trunk that once belonged to Arthur Blennerhassett was in 2002 presented by its owner Ginnie (Virginia) W. Johnston to Arthur's g.g.son, Bob Hassett of W.Grove, Pennsylvania / Her family tradition is that a relative of Arthur Blennerhassett left the trunk with her great uncle George O'Brien (b.1853 d.1936) of Fair Haven when he "...went west..."; George O'Brien's father Murtha O'Brien had emig. from Ireland to Vermont at about the same date as Arthur BH, c1848 so the families may well have been friends; the description "went west" best fits Arthur's g.son Robert Daniel Hassett b.1880, who in his youth did just that and settled in Washington state /

The trunk, which perhaps came from Ireland with Arthur in 1848, is lined with wallpaper and has "Arthur Blennerhassett" cut on the front /

Bob Hassett describes it "...an all-wood chest that has seen years of use, top has been nailed down at least two times. The name is still distinct. The caps are 1" high and the rest 1/2". The letters appear to be cut in, like with a chisel or knife..."
