 (microfilm at the National Library of Australia, ACT Australian Capital Territory) Horsebreaker, of Co.Kerry, Ireland (1835); Tried at Tralee, Co.Kerry 13.3.1835 for robbery & assault ("...felony of a piece of corduroy and assault..."); Convicted; Transported for life to New South Wales, Australia on ship "Hive" (arrived 24.12.1835; 2nd voyage that year); in prison 8.7.1836;
